



Paper Tube Binoculars

Use your binoculars to take a closer look at all the delicious food at your meal site!

Materials

- 2 toilet paper rolls or 1 paper towel roll, cut in half
- Markers, crayons, stickers, etc.
- 3-foot and 1-foot long pieces of yarn
- Scissors
- Glue stick

Instructions



- 1. Decorate your toilet paper rolls with your drawings and/or stickers of favorite fruits and vegetables.
- 2. Once you are done decorating, connect the toilet paper tubes together using the 3-foot piece yarn. Use a figure 8 maneuver, wrapping the yarn around the middle of each tube, until you run out of yarn. Glue the end piece of yarn to one of the tubes so it does not unravel.
- 3. Attach one end the 1-foot piece of yarn to each toilet paper roll to use as a strap.
