

Finger Print Corn on the Cob

Materials

- Black or white construction paper
- Yellow construction paper
- Green construction paper
- Green paint
- Orange paint
- Yellow paint
- Glue
- Paintbrush

Instructions



- 1. Cut a large oval out of the yellow construction paper and two smaller ovals out of the green construction paper.
- 2. Glue the yellow oval in the middle of the black or white construction paper.
- 3. Glue the two green ovals slightly tilted in the opposite directions and covering the bottom portion of the yellow oval (see picture above).
- 4. Have each student paint their thumb green and place green thumb prints all over the green ovals.
- 5. Have the students wash the green paint off their thumb. Repaint their thumb with orange paint and their pointer finger with yellow paint.
- 6. Alternate putting yellow and orange finger prints on the yellow oval, repainting the fingers as needed.
