

Pompom Blueberry Bush

Materials

- Paper
- Blue pompoms
- Green paint
- Brown paint or marker
- Glue



Instructions

1. Dip one of the pompoms into the green paint. Dab it on the paper in a circle to make a bush.
2. Let the paint dry.
3. Draw a brown stump at the bottom of the bush.
4. Glue blue pompoms on the bush like blueberries!

Optional: draw or paint around the bush to create a beautiful garden! Try adding trees, grass, a sun, and other fruits or vegetables.
