







Watermelon Addition and Subtraction Games

Fun, educational games to learn about math and Watermelon Day!

Materials

- Paper plate
- Green paint
- Pink or red paint
- Black buttons
- Black marker

Instructions

- 1. Paint the middle of the paper plate pink.
- 2. Paint the outer part of the paper plate green.
- 3. Give the paint time to dry completely.
- 4. After the paint is dry, draw a line down the middle of the plate to split it in half.
- 5. Use black buttons (to look like watermelon seeds) to play addition/subtraction games!

Game Examples

- Addition: 4+5=____
 - Put 4 buttons on one half and five on the other. Count the number of buttons total to get the answer.
- Subtraction: 10-3=___
 - Put 10 buttons on one side and move 3 buttons to the other. Count how many buttons remain on the first side for the final answer.

This activity is recommended for children over 3 years old. The buttons may present a choking hazard to young children. Adult supervision is recommended.
