

Watermelon Paper Fan

Materials

- White paper plate
- Large popsicle or craft stick
- Green marker or paint
- Pink or red marker or paint
- Black marker or paint
- Tape (masking or duct tape work well)
- Staples



Instructions

1. Flip the paper plate over so it is upside down.
2. Color or paint the center of the plate pink or red.
3. Color or paint the rim of the plate green.
4. Use the black marker or paint to create the seeds of the watermelon.
5. Fold the paper plate in half.
6. Open the plate and use the tape to attach the popsicle stick for the handle of the fan.
7. Adults (or older kids), use the stapler to seal the edges of the plate.
