

Watermelon Tissue Paper

Materials

- Black construction paper
- Red or pink tissue paper
- Green tissue paper
- Black tissue paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil



Instructions

1. Cut a piece of black construction paper in half.
2. Draw a semicircle on the half sheet of paper.
3. Ball up and glue green tissue paper along the curved edge of the semicircle.
4. In the remaining open space of the semicircle, ball up and glue a few pieces of black tissue paper sporadically.
5. Fill the rest of the empty space within the semicircle with balled up pink or red tissue paper.
