

Sun Headband

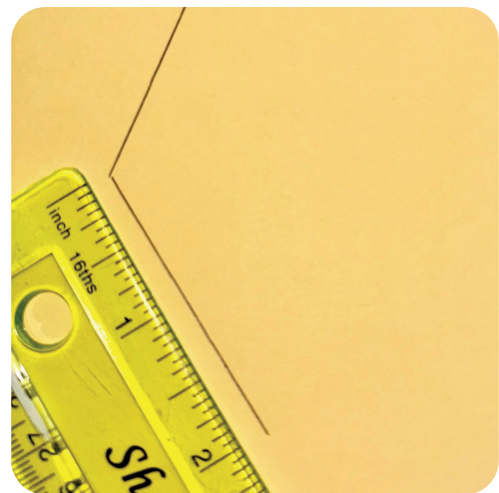
Materials

- Ruler
- Pencil
- Yellow / orange cardstock
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Plain headband
- Binder clips or paper clips



Instructions

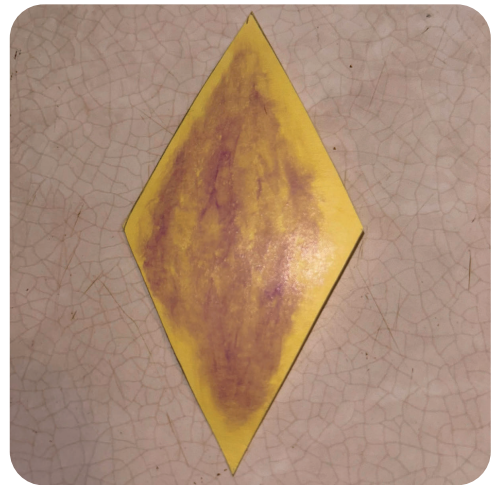
1. Using a ruler as guide, draw diamonds on your cardstock (about 2 inches long on each side).
2. Cut the diamonds. You will need about 10-12 diamonds to fill out the band.

3. Put glue on one side of a diamond and fold it around the headband so that the glued sides touch and the points are angled upwards. Press the ends of the paper firmly together until dry. You can also use binder clips or paper clips to hold the points of your diamonds together until the glue has dried.



4. Repeat with all the other diamonds, slightly overlapping each one as you move across your headband until you have filled it.



Once your glue is dried, your headband is complete!
